Call to order:

Jamie Cox, Chair called the meeting to order.

Public Comment:

Chair Cox opened the floor to allow public comment. No one present wished to address the Board.

Approval of Board Minutes:

Mr. Roberts moved and Ms. Seese seconded the motion to approve the July 20, 2021 minutes as submitted. The motion passed unanimously.

Director's Report:

Year-to-Date Budget Report:

The director provided the monthly budget report and reported sufficient funds to carry out the work of the Board.

Voter Registration Statistical Report:

The director presented the voter registration statistical report showing 104,914 registered voters. Registered voters increased by 111 since July 20, 2021.

The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Seese moved and Ms. Mebane seconded the motion to adopt a resolution merging the Lion’s Club precinct into the surrounding Carrboro, Owasa, and Town Hall precincts. The motion passed unanimously. The adopted resolution shall be forwarded to the Executive Director of the State Board of Elections for approval as required.

Director Raper provided the Board a report with her recommendations for Election Day voting location changes. The recommendations are as follows:

- Cedar Falls voting location:
Use the theater lobby at East Chapel Hill High School, 500 Weaver Dairy Rd, Chapel Hill. The distance from the former voting location at the Chapel Hill Bible Church is 1.4 miles.
- Glenwood voting location:
Use the gym at Rashkis Elementary School, 601 Meadowmont Ln, Chapel Hill. The distance from the former voting location at the Friday Center is 1.8 miles.
- Town Hall voting location:
Use the newly acquired building in the back of the Town Hall Complex, 108 Bim St, Carrboro. The distance from the former voting location in Town Hall is 479 feet.

Ms. Brodie moved and Mr. Roberts seconded the motion to adopt the recommendations of voting location changes submitted by Director Raper. The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Seese moved and Ms. Brodie seconded the motion to adopt a resolution changing the name of the Cameron Park precinct to Hillsborough North. The motion passed unanimously. The adopted resolution shall be forwarded to the Executive Director of the State Board of Elections for approval as required.

Mr. Roberts moved and Ms. Seese seconded the motion the Board move into closed session as permitted in NCGS 143-318.11(a)(6) to discuss precinct personnel. The motion was unanimous. Ms. Seese moved and Ms. Mebane seconded the motion the Board return to open session. The motion was unanimous. Mr. Roberts moved and Ms. Seese seconded the motion to approve the precinct official appointments as discussed. The motion was unanimous. Appointment cards shall be mailed to all those appointed. A list of those appointed shall be placed on file with the Board minutes.

Adjournment:

Ms. Seese moved and Ms. Brodie seconded the motion the Board adjourn. The motion passed unanimously.
