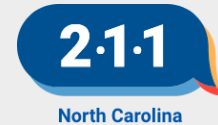

NEED HELP WITH RENT OR UTILITY PAYMENTS?

The Orange County Housing and Community Development Department is administering a new statewide program that may be able to provide help.

To be eligible, you must:

- Earn an income less than or equal to 80% of the area median income for your county.
- Live in a rental unit and be named on the lease or rental agreement.
- Experience difficulty paying rent due to COVID-19 impacts.
- Be behind on your rent and/or utilities as of April 1, 2020.

In Orange County, households at 80% of the area median are:
